This two-day course provides training for development and implementation of a new laboratory management system in compliance with the new **ISO/IEC 17025:2017** requirements.

Objective

This two-day course provides detail explanation of the principles and requirements of quality and technical aspects of the international standard ISO/IEC 17025:2017. It provides participants guidelines for building up an effective new quality management system (QMS) for laboratory operation. The ISO 17025:2017 is completely revised to align with the newly issued ISO 9001:2015 in terms of the "Risk Assessment" reference to ISO 31000:2019 and also ILAC G8-09:2019 on "Decision Rules". The concept of the "Certified Reference Materials" and the "Metrology & Traceability" are also introduced in this standard.

Emphasis is also given to fulfilling corresponding Accreditation Body's (i.e. ANAB, GAC, HKAS and IAS) requirements, preparation of new accreditation or reassessment getting ready in particular for the HOKLAS assessments for Hong Kong based laboratories. On completion of the course, participants shall have adequate knowledge to establish, implement and maintain an effective laboratory management system to ISO/IEC 17025:2017; and to understand the accreditation process and to undertake structured preparation for HOKLAS or other Accreditation Body's assessments to the ISO/IEC 17025:2017 standard.
